Methodology Note: The reported voting intention figures are based on a combination of first choice for the vast majority of respondents and second choice for 28 people whose first choice party is not actually standing in their constituency. This change has been made to account for the Brexit Party standing aside in Conservative-held seats, and the pact agreed between the Liberal Democrats, Plaid Cymru and the Green Party. The effect of this is to increase the Conservative share by 1% without affecting the Labour or Lib Dem percentages.
