The headline voting intention figures for our poll are as follows: **LAB 33%, CON 33%, UKIP 17%, LD 7%, GRN 5%, SNP 3%, OTHER 2%**

When pressed to choose between a Labour or Conservative government, the outcome was 50:50

60% say they will either definitely or probably watch tonight's debate. We asked them a series of questions about the seven party leaders (results below excluding Don't Know, full results in the tables):

Which one of the seven leaders taking part do you think...

...is likely to win the debate - Cameron 38%, Miliband 25%, Farage 25%

...is the most charismatic leader - Farage 38% Cameron 32%, Miliband 11%

...is the strongest leader - Cameron 53%, Miliband, 16% Farage 16%

...is the most annoying - Farage 28%, Miliband 27%, Cameron 19%

...has the best sense of humour - Farage 55%, Miliband 15%, Cameron 14%

...is most in favour of a more equal society - Miliband 36%, Cameron 19%, Clegg 16%
